CSIRO Workforce COVID-19 Response Scenarios

- Scenario 1: If you are unwell or have any flu-like symptoms or think you may have been exposed to COVID-19, you must stay at home.
- Scenario 2: If you or a member of your household or close contact has had a test for COVID-19, you must stay at home, until the results of the test/s are known.
- Scenario 3: If you or a member of your household or close contact, tests positive for COVID-19, you must stay at home for at least two weeks and notify your line manager immediately. The notification must include details of any visits to a CSIRO site and any contacts with CSIRO officers, on or off site, in the previous two weeks.
- Scenario 4: Where a line manager has been notified that a CSIRO officer, or a member of their household or close contact, has tested positive for COVID-19, the line manager shall notify HSE and all other officers that have had contact with the officer or contact with affected work area/s on site.
- Scenario 5: If you are in a COVID-19 lockdown or hotspot area as determined by Government, you must inform your line manager and work from home as recommended by Government, unless you receive special approval from the site leader to be on a CSIRO site.
- Scenario 6: If you are over the age of 70, over the age of 60 with existing health conditions, an Indigenous Australian over the age of 50 with existing health conditions, or have a chronic condition or compromised immune system, you must work from home, unless you have special approval from the site leader to be on a CSIRO site.

These scenarios apply to all CSIRO staff, affiliates and visitors to site.
