The CSIRO Staff Association, representing hundreds of the world's leading scientists on climate change and the environment, supports the national School Strike 4 Climate on 15 March. Climate change is the biggest threat to the survival of our planet and to the sustainability of future generations.

CSIRO staff know more than anyone the impact of attacks on climate science. In 2016, more than a hundred climate researchers were set to be axed under the Coalition Government, until the Staff Association and community groups fought back to save more than half of the jobs and establish a new Climate Science Centre in CSIRO.

The Staff Association expresses our solidarity with students around the country taking a stand for real action on climate change on Friday. The strikes should be a strong signal to all politicians and decision makers that future generations will not accept the current inaction on addressing the existential threat of climate change.
