Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00 noon Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 25/09/2019.

Candidate Statements

Candidates for offices which constitute the Governing Council may lodge a written statement, of no more than 250 words, in support of their candidature. Statements which comply with the Union's Rules will be distributed with the ballot papers. Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12:00 noon (Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT)) on 09/10/2019 can be accepted.

Please submit your Statement to the Returning Officer as a word document (.doc) either by email to nswelections@aec.gov.au or on a cd.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 06/11/2019 and close at 10:00am Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 11/12/2019.
