John Little (study) scholarships

John Little (Study) Scholarships support members who are undertaking study leading to the award of a formal qualification, and who are classified up to CSOF Level 3 Max in CSIRO, or up to APS Level 4 in the Australian Astronomical Observatory and the National Measurement Institute.

The scholarships are \$1,000 each and assist with the costs of study related expenses, including course fees and materials. Up to three scholarships are awarded each year.

Who was John Little?

John Little was a former Technical Association Federal President and Victorian Branch Chairman and one of the stalwarts of the Association. It was John's foresight that set the Association on the path to professionalism. Following his untimely death due to a heart attack, the Association Council decided to establish the Scholarship in his honour.

The Scholarship recognises the importance of study in developing the skills and qualifications of staff that are classified up to CSOF Level 3 Max in CSIRO or up to APS Level 4 in the Australian Astronomical Observatory and the National Measurement Institute.

Conditions

- Be financial members of the CSIRO Staff Association;
- Be classified no higher than CSOF Level 3 Max in CSIRO or no higher than APS Level 4 in the Australian Astronomical Observatory and the National Measurement Institute;
- Be undertaking or enrolled to undertake a course of study leading to the award of a formal qualification; and
- Not have received a John Little Scholarship on any previous occasion.

Applications must be countersigned by a Staff Association workplace delegate <u>or</u> member prior to being submitted. The Staff Association Executive selects the winners each year.
