Step up and nominate as a Workplace Health & Safety Representative

Health and Safety Representatives (HSRs) are employees, democratically elected by colleagues, to independently represent staff and help keep workplaces safe.

HSRs represent their Designated Work Group (DWG) with health and safety issues, concerns and interests of their colleagues. HSRs can facilitate communication and consultation and provide a crucial link between employers and employees.

Australian workplace laws allow for HSRs to receive training to fulfil the role and powers to enforce compliance with workplace health and safety legislation.

In addition to making your workplace safe, becoming a HSR is a great way to diversify your career experience by developing an additional set of skills vital for the workplace.
